"I like being a Volunteer because I like helping people, welcoming them to a new place and helping them meet other people in similar situations".

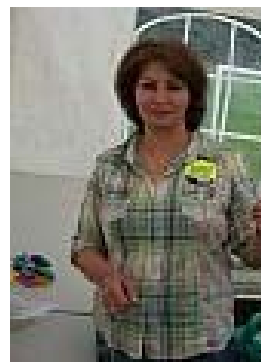
